ANNUAL ANGEL TREE CEREMONY**

The Annual Angel Tree Ceremony, hosted by Victim Assistance Program, will take place on Monday, December 2nd from 5:30-7:30 PM at the Akron-Summit County Public Library Auditorium, 60 South High Street in Akron. The ceremony will honor the memory of over 1,000 victims lost in Summit County due to violence over the last 25 years.

Victim Assistance Program invites community members, friends, and family members of homicide victims to attend and remember their loved one by placing an Angel ornament on one of the Angel Trees on display. Throughout the month of December, both the Angel Trees and the Wall of Remembrance will remain on display at the Akron-Summit County Public Library.
